REGISTRATION OF POTENTIAL SUPPLIERS/CONTRACTORS

The Municipal City Council of Port Louis (MCCPL) is currently compiling a list of suppliers who wish to be registered for the supply of Goods, Services, Works and Consultancy Services

In that respect, prospective suppliers are requested to collect and fill the Supplier Registration Form available at the Registry, Administrative Department, 2nd Floor, City Council of Port Louis or to download same from its website (<http://www.mccpl.mu>)

The duly filled form should be sealed in an envelope and addressed to the Chief Executive, The City Council of Port Louis, City Hall, Port Louis and to be deposited at the Registry, Administrative Department, 2nd Floor, City Council of Port Louis.

The under listed documents should be submitted along with the registration form.

1. A copy of the Business Registration Card and valid Trade Fee receipt
2. Certificate of Registration from the Small and Medium Enterprises Development Authority (SMEDA) wherever applicable.
3. Certificate of Registration from the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) for consultancy firms and contractors operating in the construction industry wherever applicable.

The attention of applicants is being drawn to the fact that registration does not mean that the Council has any contractual obligation towards them and does not entitle them to become exclusive providers of any goods/services. Those who have registered in previous years should register anew. The Council reserves the right to look for alternative suppliers/contractors whenever it deems necessary to do so.
