Rules and Regulations concerning the Swimming Course run by the City Council of Port Louis

- 1. The course is open to residents of Port Louis.
- 2. Swimmers having skin problems will not be given access to the pool.
- 3. Swimming suits, and other swimming gowns made of "Lycra", caps and taking a shower before entering the pool are compulsory to all swimmers.
- 4. It is strictly forbidden:
 - a) to spit inside the pool
 - b) to run/play around the pool
 - c) to use sun-bathing creams
 - d) to urinate/defecate in the pool
- 5. Swimmers must strictly follow instructions from coaches/life savers and may be dismissed from the course for showing no keen interest or unsatisfactory progress and misbehaviour.
- 6. Swimmers are expected to attend sessions regularly. Those absent for three consecutive sessions will have their names struck out without any claim.
- 7. No fees will be reimbursed if the swimmers for one reason or another decide not to follow the course.
- 8. The Municipality of Port Louis will not be held responsible for any accident and loss of any objects that may occur and for any injury that may sustain.
- 9. Seats will be allocated on the basis of first come first serve.
- 10. The Municipality reserves itself the right of making any amendments to these rules and regulations.
